

**Location:** Baltimore and Annapolis Trail Park  
Starting at Marley Station Mall, heading south along the trail to the Earleigh Heights Ranger Station. Hikers will return along the same route, heading north. (Leashed pets are allowed.)

**When:** May 17, 2008  
(Rain or shine!)

**Distance:** 7 miles  
From Marley to Earleigh is 3.5 miles one way. Hikers are welcome to begin their return route sooner if they desire a shorter route. Bathrooms and beverages will be available at Earleigh.

**Registration:** 7:00a.m. to 8:30a.m.

**Hiker Fee:** \$25 for each hiker over age 12  
This fee is waived if hiker raises over \$25.  
**Free t-shirts** (adult sizes) for hikers raising over \$25 at registration.

**Directions:** *To Marley Station Mall:*  
From Rt. 50, take exit 27 (if eastbound) or 27B (if westbound) onto MD Rt. 2 north (Ritchie Hwy.). Go about 10 1/2 miles. Just after Rt. 100, follow the signs for "Shopping Center" in the left lane. The trail is at the rear of the mall, behind Penny's and Macy's.
